

# The Dr. C. Hans Evans Memorial Scholarship Fund

## Grant Application

### Purpose

*The Dr. C. Hans Evans Memorial Scholarship Fund was established to honor the memory of Dr. C. Hans Evans, beloved pastor of The Presbyterian Church of Coatesville, PA from 1944 to 1977. The fund also seeks to perpetuate his love for the ministry and the Word of God, to encourage others in the ministry to excel as students of the Word of God and to encourage others to follow Dr Evans' example of faithful and loyal devotion to Jesus Christ.*

### The Recipient

*The recipient of each grant must be a person actively and presently engaged in Christian ministry who desires further training for that ministry. "Ministry" is interpreted as: 1) presently engaged as a pastor in a church, or 2) presently holding a position on a church staff such as Christian Education director, etc, or 3) on faculty or staff of a Christian college or Christian day school, or 4) a professional working in an evangelical Christian organization. Recipient must have United States Citizenship status.*

*This Scholarship is not for those going to college or seminary unless they meet the above requirements. There is a limit of two scholarships per individual.*

### Doctrinal Statement

*We believe in the Holy Trinity, consisting of God the Father, Jesus Christ the Son, and the Holy Spirit.*

- In the virgin birth of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, who was begotten of the Holy Spirit and is true God and true man.*
- In the sinfulness of men and in salvation through personal faith in Christ; in His bodily resurrection in His present ministry of intercession and in His personal return for His Church.*
- In the Holy Spirit as a person who proceeds from the Father and the Son, by whom every believer is regenerated, indwelt, empowered and sealed into the Body of Christ when he believes.*
- In the Holy Scriptures as the inspired, inerrant Word of God, the only infallible rule of faith and practice.*
